1. Aims of the competition

To determine the Czech National Champion in Wingsuit Performance Flying.

To promote and develop Wingsuit Flying training and competition.

To establish new Wingsuit Flying competition records.

To present a visually attractive image of the competition jumps and timely standings (scores) for competitors, spectators and media.

To exchange ideas and strengthen friendly relations between wingsuit flyers, judges and support personnel of all nations.

To allow participants to share and exchange experience, knowledge and information.

4. General Conditions

- The L-410 aircraft or similar will be used for the competition.

- The FAI Competition Rules will be used for the competition.
- The DZ rules must be followed by all competitors. All participants will be briefed with the DZ rules during the Competitors Meeting.
- All skydivers at the DZ Prostejov must use the AAD.

5. Rules and Regulations

- Minimum competitors to determine the Czech National Champion is 3.
- Next to the Czech Champion there will be awarded the absolute winner 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in both categories Advanced and Intermediate.
- The objective is to fly a single wingsuit in three separate tasks to demonstrate a combination of best lift (time task), best glide (distance task) and least drag (speed task).
- Each round of the event is comprised of the three tasks.
- Each task is performed on a separate flight.
- A competition shall consist of three rounds, with three tasks in each round, for a total of nine flights.
- At least one round must be completed to determine rankings and declare winners.
- The minimum exit altitude is 3200m/10,500ft Geometric Altitude. The maximum exit altitude (at the start of jump run) is 3353m/11,000ft Geometric Altitude.
- The competition window is 2500m-1500m.
- Every competitor has to bring his own FlySight PLD for the judging system according to the FAI rules https://www.fai.org/sites/default/files/isc/documents/2021/2021_isc_ws_competition_rules_v2.pdf
- In case the competitor doesn't have his own FlySight he might rent for a fee and after prior agreement (min 14 days before start of the competition) from the organizer.
- The scoring will be determined by a FAI judge.
- PROTESTS
- If dissatisfied with the decision on a complaint made during the competition, a competitor has the right of protest. Such a protest must be made in writing, in English, and be handed by the competitor to the Meet Director together with the protest fee 40€ within the time limit of 60 minutes. The deposited fee is returnable only if the protest is upheld, or is withdrawn prior to the hearing by the Jury.
